Pursuant to Article 11 item 6, Article 13 paragraph 2 and Article 32 paragraph 6 of the Law on Marine Fisheries (Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro 55/03), the Ministry of Agriculture, Forestry and Water Management has issued the

R U L E B O O K

**ON AMOUNT OF FEE FOR COMMERCIAL FISHING (CATCH AND FARMING), PERMIT FORM
AND METHOD OF KEEPING REGISTERS OF PERMITS ISSUED**

Rulebook was published in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro

10/2004 of 19 February 2004

Article 1

Companies, entrepreneurs and natural persons fulfilling the requirements for commercial fishing referred to in Article 10 and Article 32 paragraph 1 of the Law on Marine Fisheries, shall pay a fee for commercial fishing in single amounts, depending on the type and the capacity of the fishing means as well as on the significance of the fishing, as follows:

- by engine power EUR 3 pr every kilowatt;
- for bottom trawls EUR 200;
- for pelagic trawls EUR 100;
- for entangling nets EUR 50;
- for seines EUR 180;
- for coastal trawls EUR 80;
- for gillnet EUR 80;
- fish trap EUR 10;
- trident EUR 30;
- bottom longline EUR 0.50 (per hook);
- floating longline EUR 0.20 (per hook);
- trap for Norway lobster EUR 10;
- trap for big crustaceans EUR 15;
- collecting of bivalve molluscs by dredge or excavator EUR 5,000;
- catch of collecting of other marine organisms EUR 2,500;
- *kalimera* EUR 200;
- *grib* EUR 200;
- collecting of bivalve molluscs EUR 300;
- fish farming in the Bay of Boka Kotorska EUR 0.05 per m²;
- bivalve molluscs farming in the Bay of Boka Kotorska EUR 0.03 per m²;
- farming of fish and bivalve molluscs in open sea EUR 0.02 m².

Article 2

Number of equipment and gear that may be used in small-scale commercial fishing amounts to not more than:

- net – 2 pcs;
- traps – 10 pcs;
- tridents – 1 pcs;
- longline – 200 hooks;
- seine – 1 pcs;
- *kalimera* – 1 pcs;
- lantern of 800 candle power.

Article 3

The fee referred to in Article 1 of this Rulebook is paid for the period of validity of the fishing permit, or farming permit, as appropriate.

The fee for fishing is paid every year and is valid for the calendar year in which the permit was issued, while for farming purposes, the fee is paid for every year separately.

Forms of permits referred to in the paragraph 1 of this Article are printed with this Rulebook, that they are integral part of.

Article 4

The register of fishing permits issued and the register of the farming permits issued are kept by the administration authority in charge of marine fisheries.

The entry in the register referred to in the paragraph 1 of this Article is done *ex officio*, in accordance with the form of the register for fishing, or the register for farming, as appropriate, printed with this rulebook, that they are integral part of.

Article 5

The data necessary for the registers referred to in Article 4 of this Rulebook are entered from the fishing permits, or farming permits, as appropriate, as well as all the changes that relate to the permits issued.

Article 6

Companies, entrepreneurs, as well as natural persons to whom the fishing permit or the farming permit was issued are entered in the registers referred to in the Article 4 of this Rulebook, as well as the equipment and gear used for fishing or farming purposes.

Article 7

The following shall be entered in the registers referred to in the Article 4 of this Rulebook:

- companies and entrepreneurs, by their respective ownership forms, or a foreign legal person, etc;
- natural person to whom the fishing permit, or the farming permit, as appropriate, was issued as an employee or a retiree.

Article 8

Register of fishing or farming are kept in a hardback book with enumerated pages.

Before use, the book of registers referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article must be stamped by the administration authority in charge of marine fisheries.

Article 9

The entry of data in the registers referred to in Article 4 of this Rulebook is done in ink or by ballpoint pen.

In case a mistake is made when entering the data, the correction is done by crossing out the incorrect word or a part of the text so as to leave the original text legible, and the new text is written above it, in red ink or by a red ballpoint pen.

Each entry into the registers referred to in paragraph 1 of this Article shall be at the end of the text signed by the officer in charge who entered the data in the register.

Article 10

A set of documents is kept together with the registers referred to in the Article 4 of this Rulebook where documents for each company, entrepreneur or natural person to whom the permit was issued is placed by the ordinal number under which they were entered into the abovementioned registers.

Article 11

The registers referred to in the Article 4 of this Rulebook are public.

The administration body in charge of marine fisheries shall allow insight into the registers to every person interested, and upon such request it shall issue a copy on certain entries.

Article 12

The day this Rulebook enters into force, the Rulebook on method of keeping and forms of the fisheries register, permits for commercial and permits for sport fishing at sea (Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro 53/92) shall be repealed.

Article 13

This Rulebook shall enter into force on the eighth day from the day of its publishing in the Official Gazette of the Republic of Montenegro.
