## ON RATIFICATION OF THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON FREE TRADE BETWEEN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

### Article 1

This is to ratify the Agreement between the Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on Free Trade between the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Russian Federation, concluded on 28 August 2000 at Belgrade, in original in Serbian and Russian language.

### Article 2

The text of the Agreement in original in Serbian language is as follows:

### AGREEMENT

### BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON FREE TRADE BETWEEN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

The Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as: "Contracting Parties"),

determined to freely improve and deepen mutual trade and economic cooperation,

confirming loyalty to the principles of market economy, as the basis of trade and economic relationships,

confirming intention to actively participate and encourage widening of mutually beneficial trade and economic relationships,

creating necessary conditions for free flow of goods and capital according to valid legislature in each state and rules of the World Trade Organization (WTO),

agreed as follows:

# Article 1

### General provisions

The Contracting Parties shall liberalise mutual trade according to the provisions of this Agreement and provisions of the WTO, aiming to establish regime of free trade.

# Article 2

### Aims of the Agreement

Aims of this Agreement are:

- widening and stimulating mutual trade and economic relationships, aiming to speed up economic development of the two states, improvement of conditions of life and work, increase of employment of population, in the field of production, achieving production and financial stability of both states;
- providing conditions for fair competition among economic entities of both states;
- harmonization of customs proceedings and ways of applying of rules on origin of goods, according to norms of international practice and synchronizing procedure of control of the origin of goods by customs authorities of both states.

# Article 3

# Scope of Application

Provisions of this Agreement shall apply to the products from Titles 1 to 97 of the nomenclature of the Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System, according to the International Convention on Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (Brussels, 14 June 1983) or customs tariffs of each state.

# Article 4

### Import Customs Duties and Other Fees

Contracting Parties shall endeavour to undertake, during five-year period, synchronised measures for gradual cancellation, in mutual trade, of import customs duties, fees and other measures of adequate foreign trade influence for goods originating from the customs territories of Contracting Parties.

Contracting Parties shall each year synchronize exemptions from the regime referred to in Article 1 of this Agreement that shall apply on the basis of bilateral protocols, signed by Contracting Parties according to the legislature of their states.

Fees and customs filing shall be collected according to the legislature of each Contracting Party.

# Article 5

# **Technical Normative Acts**

Contracting Parties shall collaborate and exchange information in the field of standardization, metrology, establishing of concordance for avoiding technical obstacles in mutual trade.

For the sake of realization of provisions of this Agreement, Contracting Parties shall conclude Agreements on mutual acceptance of reports on testing, certificates on concordance or other deeds, that in the indirect or direct way refer to products subject to the barter between two states.

Conditions and methods of concordance of products by Normative Acts are set by authorised organizations of Contracting Parties according to the legislature in importing state.

# Article 6

## Sanitary-hygienic, Veterinarian, and Phytosanitary Measures

Contracting Parties shall apply normative acts of their states regarding veterinary, quarantine and protection of plants, especially in part from the competence of adequate international institutions, offering information on spread of contagious diseases at livestock and quarantine diseases, pests and weeds with plants, as well as during synchronization of necessary documents for mutual dispatch and transit of goods.

Contracting Parties shall apply normative acts of their states in the field of veterinary, protection of plants, and animals on an non discriminatory basis, according to the Agreement between the Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of agro-industrial complexes, the Agreement between the Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of Veterinary and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of Veterinary and the Agreement between the Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of Veterinary and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on cooperation in the field of Quarantine and protection of plants, signed on 31 October 1996 at Belgrade.

# Article 7

## **Origin of Goods**

Origin of goods shall be set on the basis of rules stipulated legislature of the importing state.

Contracting Parties shall exchange rules on origin of goods stipulated by legislature of their states at the moment of signing of this Agreement.

In the case of making amendments to the abovementioned rules of origin of goods, Contracting Party that enters changes shall inform in writing other Contracting Party on changes. Other Contracting Party shall, within 15 days after receiving of notice, inform on that interested participants of foreign trade of their state.

### Article 8

## Transit of Goods

Contracting Parties shall provide free transit of goods with origin from the customs territory of the state of one of the Contracting Party that is transported over the territory of the state of the other Contracting Party, according to the legislature of their states.

# Article 9

# **Re-export of Goods**

Contracting Party shall not allow non-sanctioned re-export of goods originating from customs territory of the state of the other Contracting Party, for whose export are applied measures of customs and out of customs regulating.

# Article 10

# **General Exemptions**

This Agreement does not disturb right of each Contracting Party to apply ban or limitation to import, export or transit of goods when it is justified from the point of view of ethics, public order or state security or for protection of life and health of people, animals, or plants and environment, protection of national treasure of artistic, historic and archaeological worth, protection of intellectual property or rules referring to import and export of gold or sliver or reservation of exhaustible natural resources, when such measures are realised simultaneously with limitations of domestic production or consumption.

The abovementioned bans or limitations must not represent mean for intentional discrimination or hidden restriction to trade between the Contracting Parties.

Contracting Parties does not exclude application of measure of surveillance and control of export and import of goods, as well as technology summed by international control of origin from customs territory of the Contracting Parties.

### Article 11

### Exemptions Regarding Security

In this Agreement nothing should be interpreted as a request to one of the Contracting Parties to deliver information whose publication, according to the opinion of that Contracting Party, would be contrary to the interests of its national security, or to prevent that Contracting Party to undertake measures it considers necessary for protection of interests of its security, referring to the fission matter or materials serving for their production; or to trade of weapons, ammunition and military material, as well as to the trade of other goods and materials if such trade directly or indirectly is realised for supplying armed forces; and/or if such measures are applied during war or in other emergency situations in international relationships.

For the goods that at import or export is applied regime of sanctions set by international treaties undersigned by Contracting Parties, authorised bodies of the Contracting Parties shall issue permits for export or import, according to valid legislature of each state.

# Article 12

### Protection of Intellectual Property

In the sense of this Agreement, protection of intellectual property covers protection of copyright and related rights including protection of computer programs and data bases, protection of inventions, industrial models and samples, trade and service marks and geographical marks on origin, protection of topography, integrated circuits and protection of confidential data.

Contracting Parties shall provide protection of rights of intellectual property, including procedures for obtaining of these rights and measures for their protection from any violation.

Above mentioned protection shall be secured according to international treaties referring to intellectual property, that states of the Contracting Parties are members.

In case that the states of one or both Contracting Parties are not signatories of above mentioned treaties principle of reciprocity and non discrimination shall apply.

# Article 13 Payments

All payments between states of the Contracting Parties shall be performed according to the Article 4 of the Agreement between the Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on trade and economic cooperation of 24 August 1994.

Payments referring to trade of goods between commercial entities of the states of the Contracting Parties and transfer of this payment to the territory of one of these states, where the creditor has principal office, does not comply with limitations.

Contracting Parties shall abstain from administrative limitations during approval or payment of short-term or middle-term credits, covering trade transactions of commercial entities of their states.

# Article 14

# Anti-dumping and Compensatory Measures

Provisions of this Agreement in no way limit right of the Contracting Parties that after carrying out of adequate procedure bring decision on change of anti-dumping or compensatory measures according to legislature of their states, under conditions, and/or according to procedure stipulated in Article 16 of this Agreement.

# Article 15

# **Special Protection Measures**

If some product is imported to the Customs territory of one state of the Contracting Parties in such quantities and under such terms and conditions to cause or threaten to cause serious damage to domestic producers of similar or directly competitive product in the importing state, each Contracting Party, whose interests are hit after carrying out adequate procedure can undertake adequate measures according to legislature valid in each state of the Contracting Parties, under conditions, and/or according to the procedure from Article 16 of this Agreement.

# Article 16

# Procedure for Application of Protection Measures

Before application of measures stipulated in Articles 14 and 15 of this Agreement, the Contracting Parties shall intent to solve mutual disputes through direct consultations in scope of the Working Group for improving trade-economic cooperation and perfecting mechanism of trade of Intergovernmental Yugoslav-Russian Committee for trade, economic and scientific-engineering cooperation, established according to the Agreement between the Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on establishing Intergovernmental Yugoslav-Russian Committee for trade, economic and scientific-engineering cooperation of 24 August 1994 (hereafter referred to as: "Working Group"), aiming to finding mutually acceptable solution.

The Contracting Party that brought decision on starting procedure that precede introduction of antidumping, compensatory or special protection measures provided in Articles 14 and 15 of this Agreement should inform on that other Contracting Party and send it information provided by legislature of the state of the Contracting Party that started the procedure.

If the Contracting Parties cannot find mutually acceptable solution in term of 30 days from the start of consultations in scope of the Working Group, the Contracting Party that started procedure, preceding implementation of anti-dumping, compensatory or special protection measures has right to apply, after carrying out of adequate procedure, measures to cancel harmful consequences or threat that the harmful consequences shall occur, and shall inform on that other Contracting Party.

Scope and duration of above mentioned measures shall be limited to that what is necessary to eliminate damage. While choosing measures stipulated in Articles 14 and 15 of this Agreement Contracting Parties give advantage to those measures inflicting least damage to achieving aims of this Agreement.

In extreme circumstances, when prolonging of applying of measures stipulated in Articles 14 and 15 of this Agreement can lead to damage that can be hard to compensate, the Contracting Party, that started procedure of applying of protection measures, can apply temporary measures before making consultations, under the condition that consultations shall take place immediately after applying of these measures.

# Article 17

# Failure to Meet Obligations

If one Contracting Party considers that the other Contracting Party failed to meet certain obligation from this Agreement, it can, after the end of consultations or after expiry of the period of 3 months from the date of informing the other Contracting Party, undertake necessary measures for cancellation of circumstances of inflicted damage.

# Article 18

# Influence of Balance of Payment

If one of the Contracting Parties has serious difficulties of the balance of payment or there is danger of appearance of such situation, it can implement restrictive measures, including those that concern import of goods and are of limited duration, until those difficulties persist.

That Contracting Party should timely inform the other Contracting Party on intention of implementing above mentioned measures of limitations and on period of their duration and cancellation.

# Article 19

# **Evolutionary Clause**

If one of the Contracting Parties considers expedient that provisions of this Agreement should widen to other fields of trade-economic cooperation not stipulated by this Agreement, it shall provide to the other Contracting Party documented suggestion. When that suggestion is accepted this Agreement can be amended, according to legislature of the Contracting Parties.

# Article 20

# Control of Execution of the Agreement

The Working Group stated in Article 16 of the Agreement shall take care on the execution of this Agreement.

The Working Group shall meet for the consideration of execution of this Agreement and dispute cases, when necessary, at least two times per year.

# Article 21

# **Enforcement and Validity**

The Agreement shall apply of the date of its signing, and comes into force on the date of the last written information that the Contracting Parties fulfilled national procedure necessary for its enforcement.

This Agreement is concluded for not limited time and ceases to be valid after six months from the date of written information of one Contracting Party, on intention to cancel the Agreement.

Treaties concluded in scope of this Agreement that are not realised until the moment of cease of its validity remain in force until its complete execution, according to the provisions of this Agreement.

### PROTOCOL

# ON EXEMPTIONS FROM FREE TRADE REGIME ACCOMPANYING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION ON FREE TRADE BETWEEN THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF YUGOSLAVIA AND THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

The Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation, hereinafter referred to as "Parties" concluded the Protocol on the following:

### Article 1

Exemptions, stipulated by the Article 4, paragraph 2 of the Agreement between the Federal Government of the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Government of the Russian Federation on Free Trade between the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Russian Federation of 28 August 2000, hereinafter referred to as: "the Agreement" refers to:

products contained in Annex 1, 2, and 3 of this Protocol,

those products to which, according to the Russian legislature, export customs duties, licences and contingents for export of goods (businesses and services) shall be applied.

# Article 2

Medications imported to customs territory of the Russian Federation from the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia according to Annex no 2 of this Protocol shall be excluded from import customs duties or special reduced customs duties stated in Annex 2 shall apply.

# Article 3

The Parties shall mutually inform on introduction of exemptions from regime of Free Trade for products, stipulated in Annex 1, 2, and 3 of this Protocol, as well as on application of import customs duties according to the Article 2 of the Protocol, at least two months before their introduction.

### Article 4

This Protocol and all its Annexes constitute integral part of the Agreement.

# Article 5

This Protocol shall apply as of the date of its signing, and shall come into force on the date of coming to force of the Agreement and shall be valid until signing of a new Protocol between Parties, regarding questions regulated by this Protocol, according to Article 4, paragraph 2 of the Agreement.
